

# SHELLSHOCK

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Shellshock, named after a *New Order* song from their 1987 album, *Substance*, is owned and operated by Jeremy Alexis and Anthony Marty. The boat is located in Chicago, just east of Grant Park, at Monroe Harbor. She is located at mooring can **North November 29 (NN29)**. You will need this when you board the Tender Service at the Monroe Harbor Master.

Built in 1994, this 30-foot, J/92 racing class sailboat is the 66th hull built since its introduction in 1992. The first owners gave her the name of *Turbulence*, which stood until her current owners renamed her *Shellshock*, in June of 2006. The last J/92 (hull #180) was built from the factory in Rhode Island in 2003. For more info, go to the J Boats website, <http://www.jboats.com/j92/>.

Shellshock is a very light and fast racing vessel, that likes to heel. This comes at a trade off - lack of comfort amenities, offering only the bare minimum of a toilet and sink. There is a portable cooler to keep the beverages and foods cold, but no stove to warm them in. Although the boat is streamlined for high performance, safety has not been forsaken. ## Frequently Asked Questions

- **I don't know anything about boating, is this okay?** Relax, you will not be expected to do any work on the boat.
- **I can't swim and the water scares me?** No worries. We have PFDs (personal flotation devices) on board.
- **Is there something I can do to prevent motion sickness?** You can get over the counter pills, patches and/or wrist bands that nullify the effects of motion sickness. Note that Shellshock has a deep and heavy keel, which will make the boat more stable than most power boats, although there will be a little heeling.
- **Can I bring a small child and/or pet?** As the boat has an open aft cockpit, we feel that this is not a good idea.
- **Other than transportation and/or parking, is there anything I need to buy?** A Tender Service pass (\$4 one way, purchased at the Monroe Harbor Master) will allow you to be shuttled, on a water taxi, to where Shellshock is moored. Note that you can buy a book of ten passes for \$30 - great for large groups or regular guests.
- **What are the Tender's hours?** Monday-Thursday, 0900-2330. Friday 0900, running continuously to Sunday 2330.
- **What should I wear?** Dress accordingly and think layers. Sunglasses, hat and your favorite sunscreen are recommended. There is a limited amount of space on the boat, please make sure to fit it all in a small backpack. Please do not bring black soled shoes or footwear that would mark up the white deck.
- **I heard that red wine marks up the boat, and I have this really great Château Lafite-Rothschild, can I still bring it?** Duh, of course you can. Yes, red wine will mark up the boat, but we have no intention of spilling the stuff.
- **Is there somewhere I can purchase a bag of ice?** The Harbor Master sells ice. Buy your ticket (\$2 for one bag) from them, grab your ice from the ice chest at the end of the dock and bring it on board the Tender, where you can place it into the cooler on board. Remember to retrieve it before you board Shellshock and render the your ice ticket to the driver.
